

# Position Description August 2024

Title: Primary Instructor Foundational Levels

**Department:** Oregon Ballet Theatre School

**Position Status**: Regular Part-time, Salaried, No Benefits

**Salary**: \$17,000 annually

Effective Date: August 26, 2024 – June 8, 2025

#### **Position Overview:**

Principal Instructor Foundational levels: Including levels Pre-Ballet, Primary, and Level 1. OBT School is adopting a new curriculum for the 2024-2025 Annual Session. Class content will be set in collaboration with the School Director. Levels Primary, and Level 1 will be based on the CPYB syllabus. Character class will be set combinations from our character curriculum. The instructor will have some freedom to set class content for Creative Movement and Pre-Ballet classes. The School Director will assist in the preparations to incorporate OBT Schools' approach to teaching these levels. This position will also be involved in our annual school performance by setting class content to perform and rehearse the students in level 1. This position will be responsible for leading a demonstration at the end of the year in June for our Pre-Ballet and Primary classes. This position reports to the School Director for all responsibilities/duties

## **Essential Functions:**

- Teach weekly classes for Creative Movement, Pre-Ballet, Primary, Level 1, and Character class
- Send class updates to the parents via email
- Plan classes according to the new curriculum requirements
- Meet with the School Director to discuss students and class content
- Attend CPYB training August 2025-all expenses will be paid
- Choreograph 2-4 Minute sections for each level
- Oversee Pre-Ballet and Primary Demonstrations in June 2025
- Rehearse Level 1 as needed for ASP
- Attend trainings as needed
- Attend meetings as requested.
- Upholds the studio code of conduct
- Awareness of OBT's commitment to DEI, and participates in trainings to stay current and informed
- Other duties as assigned.

## **Working Conditions:**

This job operates in a shared professional workspace which includes rehearsal studios, as well as in large public theaters during performances.

## Work Schedule:

This is a part time 37 week 12-15 hours per week. This position requires extended hours during performance times and teacher trainings. Regular days and hours of work are scheduled Tuesday through Friday between 3:30 PM and 6:30 PM, and Saturdays 8:45 AM –3:00 PM. Additional teaching hours will be available for 9 weeks in the Summer for additional pay.

Weekly Schedule- all admin hours are flexible; teaching hours are set.

## **Supervisory Responsibility:**

This position has no direct supervisory responsibilities.

## **Compensation:**

The salary for this position is \$17,000 annually and has no healthcare benefits. Other standard benefits and practices include 40 hours Sick Leave annually, complimentary tickets to performances, complimentary School of Oregon Ballet Theatre classes for employees and immediate family, and annual performance planning and review with the process and goals mutually agreed upon in advance with the Director of OBT School.

This position's pay is based off a meeting and prep rate of \$20 per hour, a teaching rate of \$43 per hour, and stipends for other duties.
